From Northbound I-580W/I-80E, exit at University Avenue (exit 11) and stay to the right-hand side of the exit when it splits towards Frontage Road. When the lane splits again, stay to the left-hand side. At the first stop sign, turn right onto Hearst Ave and, take Sixth Street, and turn right. Take that to University Ave and turn right. Cross over the freeway into the Marina, and at the giant roundabout, turn right onto Marina Blvd. The hotel will be on the left. Members from the City of Albany can take the University Avenue exit, which has direct access to the Marina. Parking is available on-site. A map is attached for your information.

Public transit is available by taking BART to Downtown Berkeley and then boarding the 51B bus heading towards the Berkeley Marina. There are two 51B bus routes, one that ends at the Marina and one that ends at the Amtrak Station. The Amtrack route will not take you close to the hotel.
