- 2. Exit Harrison St./Oakland Ave. (watch for "PIEDMONT NEXT RIGHT" sign)
- 3. Bear left toward Oakland Ave.
- 4. Turn left at sign onto <u>Oakland Ave.</u>
- 5. Proceed 1.3 miles on <u>Oakland Ave</u>. to <u>Highland Ave</u>. (4th signal)
- 6. Turn right onto Highland Ave.
- 7. Proceed 2/10 mile to Piedmont Community Hall driveway. (Clue: Highland Ave. curves to left and then right around park and hall)
- 8. Right into parking strip. Street parking available.

FROM SOUTHBOUND 13/WARREN FREEWAY (Berkeley, Richmond)

- 1. Exit Moraga Ave./ Thornhill Ave. (watch for "PIEDMONT NEXT RIGHT" sign)
- 2. Bear right onto Moraga Ave.
- 3. Proceed on Moraga Ave. 1.1 miles to Highland Ave. (1st signal)
- 4. Turn left at signal onto Highland Ave.
